Imparting leadership skills

The training modules were; Planning, Executing and Monitoring school Improvement, Personal Qualities, Competencies and Problem Solving, Family and Community Engagement as well as Leading an Equitable and Inclusive School. Within those modules, the following skills were imparted to student-teachers; the roles of a good leader; ways on how to handle parents, students and workers; structure of school leadership as well as professionalism and ethics in education. The workshop was participatory whereby question and answers, group discussion, and role play were maximally applied by the facilitators.

Role Play



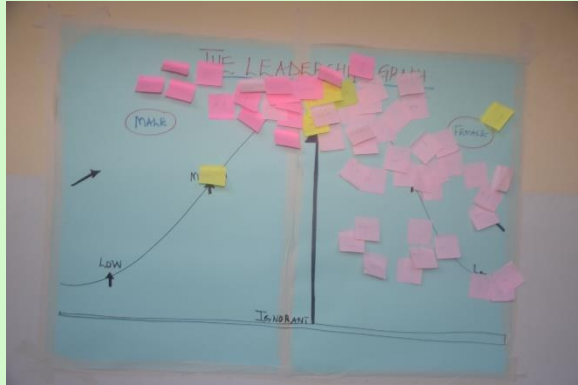
Role-Play 1: Responsible Leader (Head Master)

The role play had one scenario whereby the Head Master is at the meeting with staff. A good Head Master showed the important skills a leader should possess while on the other side the role play exposed the poor leadership skilled Head Master who treated poorly the staff as a result, the school experience poor performance.

After winding up the whole program, before closing the workshop, the third-year students had the chance to go back to the game, taking their sticking notes and move them where their leadership skills belong (low, medium or high) after the workshop. Most of them were at the highest level.
